

[HOOGLY] – JOURNAL OF VOYAGES ON THE SHIP HOOGLY

The Hooghly arrived in Western Australia in February 1830 and later continued its voyage to Sydney under the command of Captain Reeves, with George Bayly as mate. The Hooghly's last voyage was made from Calcutta to Van Diemens Land, carrying prisoners and horses, in 1842 with George Bayly as Captain. Bayly kept a comprehensive journal of all his voyages, the originals of which are in the Hocken Library, Otago, New Zealand.
