LEE STEERE FAMILY : LEAKE, Catherine Anne

Catherine Anne Leake was the daughter of Luke Leake (1784 -12 July 1838), who arrived in W.A. on the Atwick 19 October 1829, and his wife Mary Anne Walpole (1800 - 14 May 1872) who followed him on the Cygnet 27 January 1833. Catherine was born in 1834 and travelled with her mother when she returned to England after her father Luke's death. She died in Perth in 1922. James George Lee Steere was born in Surrey, England and married Catherine there on 16 June 1859. They returned to Western Australia on the Dolphin, arriving here 5 April 1860. James Lee Steere became a Member of the Legislative Council in 1868 and was elevated to Sir James in 1888.

Biography of James is filed under "Sir James Lee Steere" QB/LEE in the Battye Library.
