

## LAVER FAMILY

Jonas Laver, a farmer from Somerset, England arrived in Melbourne on board the 'Maitland' in 1846, and married Mary Ann Fry in 1854. They had seven sons, all of them helping to make up an unusually talented family in the medical, sporting and musical fields.

Their third son, Charles William Laver, was born in Castlemaine, Victoria on the 26<sup>th</sup> June 1863, and moved to Western Australia in the 1880s, where he became a drover before returning to Victoria to attend the Medical School at the University of Melbourne.

Marrying Edith Beatrice Attewell in 1904, he returned to Western Australia as a country doctor, where he was known as 'Mr the Doctor' by the Aborigines. The family lived at Laverton, Wellington Mills, Kanowna, Menzies and Midland Junction before moving to Kalgoorlie in May 1920,. Charles died in 1937, being survived by his wife and six children.

Following Dr. Laver's death, Mrs Laver and her daughters, Sheila and Elizabeth settled in East Melbourne. Sheila and Elizabeth returned to Kalgoorlie in 1979, they bought a house in Collins Street the following year, where they spent their retirement years.
