OGILVIE, Andrew Jameson

Andrew Jameson Ogilvie (1855 - 1906), Northampton and Murchison grazier, son of John and Ann Jameson (nee Maxwell), arrived possibly 20 November 1892 per Gem from Eastern Colonies. Married Ada Loela Frances Fisher in 1895, son Maxwell Jameson, born 1896. Andrew Jameson Ogilvie drowned on 8 October 1906.
