

WATKINS, DANIEL GLYN

The Venerable Daniel Glyn Watkins Archdeacon of Perth, b.1845 – d.29 June 1907.

D Glyn Watkins took his degree from Christ's College, Cambridge, in 1868 and was ordained priest in Lincoln in 1869.

He came to Western Australia in 1870 and his first charge was Greenough where, together with work in Dongara, he remained for 5 years. He then spent 30 years in Fremantle, being heavily involved in the construction of St John's Church. D Glyn Watkins married Charlotte (Carrie) Weight in England.
