

STIRLING FAMILY

Horace George Stirling; Newspaper proprietor and writer. Son of Edmund John Stirling. By 1878 editor of family newspaper "Inquirer" and "Daily news" 1882, buying up the "Herald" in 1886. Sold his interest to Arthur Lovekin in 1894, but continued writing for 30 more years.
