

FAWCETT Family

Theodore Fawcett (1832-1898), son of Colonel William Fawcett, Captain of 6th Dragoon Guards 1851, retired 1858 and came to W.A. Settled at Pinjarra as farmer and grazier. In command of Pinjarra Mounted Volunteers 1862-1882. His son Ernest married Charlotte Alderson, daughter of Rev. Richard Alderson, Rector of Pinjarra.
