

BRODIE-HALL, Laurence, Sir

Sir Laurence Brodie-Hall was born in England, 10 June 1910, the son of a London Police Constable. He immigrated to a “training farm” in New South Wales in the 1920s, and moved across to Western Australia in 1928. He first became involved in the mining industry in 1931 at Peak Hill, rising over the years to become President of the West Australian Chamber of Mines, President of the Australian Institute of Mining and Energy, WA Citizen of the Year in 1974, CMG in 1976, Knight Bachelor in 1982, Officer of the Order of Australia in 1993 and many other awards and honours. A biography “Brodie” is shelved in Battye under B/BRO.
