

BROADHURST FAMILY

Charles Edward Broadhurst, born in England in 1826 to Daniel and Sarah (nee Tootal). He was married on 22 June 1860 to (Victoria) Eliza Howes. They arrived in Western Australia on 2 May 1865 on the Warrior at Fremantle bound for the North-West. Charles' and Eliza's family of seven were: Florance Constantine b. 1861 (Victoria), d. 1909 (Cottesloe); Charles b. (Victoria) d. 1899 (England) where he trained for medicine; Sarah Eleanor b. 1865 (North-West of WA) d. 1948; Percy b. 1867 (Roebourne) d. 1945; Katherine b. 1868 (Perth), d. 1923; Ernest Edward b. 1871, d. 1872; Reginald b. 1876 (Perth) d. 1953 (England). Charles Edward Broadhurst was a pastoralist in the North-West (Ashburton River 1865-1873); a pearler; in fish canning at Mandurah; and had guano interests in the Abrolhos Islands with Alec MacNeil in 1884.

Florance Constantine Broadhurst married Harriet Heslop in 1892. Their family of five were: Harriet Constance b. 1893; Marjorie b. 1894; William Florance b. 1896; Frank Edward b. 1901; Mary Charlotte b. 1907. Florance Broadhurst was manager of his father's firm (Broadhurst, Macneil and Co) at Abrolhos Islands, taking full control in 1888 of extensive guano operations there. He also had shipping and mining interests.
