McKERN, James Gordon

Born 7 July 1888, at Hurstville, Sydney, NSW, the son of James McKern [1854 – 1941] and his wife Mary (nee Tebbutt) [1856 – 1943], the sister of Ernest Tebbutt, the founder of the law firm E.H. Tebbutt & Sons, still in practice in Sydney. James McKern senior retired in 1919 from the position of Auditor General for NSW, then known as Chief Inspector of Public Accounts.

EDUCATION:

Primary Schools, Summer Hill and Ashfield.

Secondary Schooling: enrolled 1901 at the age of 13 at Newington College, Stanmore, Sydney, where he had a brilliant academic record: Dux of every year: won a Wigram Allen Scholarship, Council Scholarship, Schofield Scholarship; appointed Senior Prefect; won the Old Boys Prize; finished school career as Dux of the school. At the Junior Public Examination conducted by the University of Sydney won both the French Medal and the School's Best Pass Medal in 1905; whilst at the University's Senior Public Examination of 1907 won First Class Honors in Greek and in Latin.

University: In 1908 was an undergraduate in the Department of Mining Engineering, winning the Levy Scholarship's for Chemistry and Physics. Graduated 1912 as B.E., Mining & Metallurgy with First Class Honors. During his studies he worked during the long vacation in various mines in order to gain practical experience; at Harden, NSW [gold]; Cobar, NSW [copper]; Wellington, NSW [copper]; and for 10 months at the Silver Peak Mine, Yerranderie, NSW, [silver-lead]
