**LAKES DISTRICT**

Crown land east of Newdegate was classified by Surveyor S.E. Smith in 1921, he named the lake on the land “Lake Damonsa”. In 1926, surveyor F.K. Pitt officially named the lake “Lake King”, after a former Surveyor-General of Western Australia. The area was first settled in 1928 under what was then known as the 3500 farm scheme.

A history of the district, “*Golden Jubilee 1928-1978*” : *Lake King, Lake Camm, Mt. Madden, Hatters Hill*” can be found in Battye Library.

This collection includes the records of various organisations within the district. Each organisation’s records have been listed under the name of the organisation. Some files did not indicate to which organisation they belong, these have been placed after the organisations listings.

The papers were donated by Mrs. Marie I Hewson on 8 August 1989 and 14 June 1990 (Acc.6702A).
