DEAN-WILLIAMS, Irene, 1903-1946

Irene Dean-Williams was born Selina Irene Schmidt in Warracknabeal, Victoria on 12 July 1903, the third daughter of John August and Selina Matilda Schmidt. John August Schmidt died in 1904 and Selina Matilda married Harry Dean-Williams in 1910. The three daughters of Selina Matilda adopted their stepfather's surname, Dean-Williams.

Irene Dean-Williams obtained her private pilot's licence on 30 May 1931, after her mother bought her a bi-plane and the renowned Harry "Cannon-Ball" Baker gave her flight instruction.

In 1932, Dean-Williams was sponsored by the Berlei Clothing Company on a flight from Maylands Aerodrome, Perth to Sydney, New South Wales.

After returning to Western Australian, Dean-Williams obtained her commercial pilot's licence. She married William McGushion in 1942 and died from cancer in July 1946. She is buried with her parents at Northam, WA.
