

## PELICAN POINT SEA SCOUT GROUP

Pelican Point Sea Scout Group was founded as “1<sup>st</sup> WA Troop Sea Scouts” in 1913. Since its establishment Pelican Point Sea Scout Group has had a special role in scouting in Western Australia. It has been the centre of sea scouting and during World War 11, a voluntary Air Observer Corps post was established at Pelican Point operating from the lookout tower. This tower was manned day and night by scouts, rovers and parents to identify, log and report any air craft sightings. They also served the community in the years before and after the war by helping capsized yachts, protecting life and property and in many other ways.

Pelican Point Sea Scouts Group is located at Camp Cornwell in Crawley and offers all levels of scouting from Joeys (6-8 year olds) to Rovers (18-25 year olds) and the site can be hired for events associated with either a full or fellowship scouting member.
