

## FORM

Craftwest Centre for Contemporary Craft was incorporated in 1986 as the State craft authority supporting traditional and fine craft practice in W.A. through advocacy, provision of professional development and exhibition opportunities. They opened a retail shop in Perth called Elemental.

In 2004 Craftwest became FORM - Building a State of Creativity, Inc., an independent, non-profit cultural organisation that develops and advocates for excellence in creativity and artistic practice in Western Australia. Their activities span high-level artist development and exhibitions, place-making and strategy, social and multicultural engagement, cultural infrastructure development, Aboriginal cultural maintenance, research, and advocacy. All of these activities are connected by the exploration of artistic excellence, whether through processes or outcomes.
