

## GARDNER FAMILY

James Stone GARDNER was born in 1891 at Lancashire, England, and migrated with his family (parents – George William and Sarah Stone Gardner - and siblings) in 1909 to Western Australia. In January 1910, the family settled in the district of Yorkkrine, in the northern part of the Shire of Tammin. This area has become known as the central wheat belt district of WA. The farm was named “Cringeleber”, after one of the farms at which the family had lived in Lancashire. While the majority of the archive relates to James and Hilda’s family, there are also significant elements of the collection that relate to the activities of his parents, George and Sarah, and his siblings, especially three brothers (Philip, Edward and Charles) and four sisters (Josephine or Jessie, Anne or Annie, Katherine or Katie, and Louisa or Louie).

George and Sarah bought a second farm, “Lyndhurst”, at Wagin in Southern WA around 1920. George became ill in the mid-1920s and returned to England, where he died in 1926. Sarah moved to Inglewood, Perth in about 1925, where she died in 1934.

James married Hilda Mary HOTHERSALL in England in 1924 and they returned to “Cringeleber”. They had three children, Marie Teresa (1925) (“Tess”), Walter James (1926), and Georgina (1934) and established a merino sheep stud. James died in 1965 and Hilda in 1974.

The collection extends from the family’s homes in England (prior to migration), through the establishment of the farm and raising of the family to the period post world War II, the late 1940s – early 1950s. It includes photographs of travels in Australia and overseas, especially of family members returning to England in the 1930s, 1951 and 1964.
