

HISTORICAL ENCYCLOPEDIA OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA RECORDS

An idea conceived in the 1990s resulted in the publication of the Historical Encyclopedia of Western Australia in 2009 under the auspices of the Centre for Western Australian History at the University of Western Australia (UWA). The overarching aim was to reshape the way the history of Western Australia could be understood by rejecting the grand narratives of the past in favour of multiple voices and multiple perspectives and to elevate the unique history of Western Australia. Under the leadership of Professor Jenny Gregory and her co-editor Dr Jan Gothard, an Editorial Advisory Board was formed and broad themes were determined with the philosophy of inclusion on the basis of race, ethnicity, gender and class underpinning choices made. The themes were further developed in a 2003 workshop comprising over ninety historians. Writing and checking of individual entries was shared between the Board and nearly 600 other writers or expert readers. In addition to historians, contributions were sought from scientists, social scientists and other scholars from the humanities.

The project was sponsored by the Australian Research Council, the Constitutional Centre of WA, the Department of Local Government and Regional Development, the Department of Premier and Cabinet, Lotterywest, and UWA. There were also eight industry partners including the Heritage Council of WA and West Australian Newspapers who provided other sorts of support. With the extensive amount of community involvement and support, the breadth of entries and the particular attention paid to the inclusion of Aboriginal knowledge, this publication is a new form of encyclopedia, a people's encyclopedia.
