

**PETERS, Nonja.** (1944-)

Dr Nonja Peters is an historian, anthropologist, museum curator and social researcher who has a special interest in Dutch maritime, military, migration and mercantile connections with Australia and the South East Asian Region since 1606. The collection includes letters and documents from her own family and collected in the course of research for books written on Dutch migration to Australia. Also memoirs written by Dutch migrants to Western Australia or recorded from interviews. Some of the migrants were residing in Java during the occupation by Japanese in World War 2.
