

RUDDUCK FAMILY

Samuel Burton Rudduck (1873-1952) and Alice Mary (nee Morton) Rudduck (1872-1952) established a farm, *Koobabbie*, at Coorow, WA from 1906-1948. Their son, Samuel Arnold Rudduck (1904-1964) and his wife Clarice Lavinia (nee Perry) (1906-1962), established *El Cala*, Coorow from 1927-1948 and *Koobabbie* from 1968-2019. The donor, Wendy Le Get (granddaughter) and family farmed *Koobabbie* 2019-2021. The donation relates to the establishment and running of the farm *Koobabbie*. *Koobabbie* has been an iconic farm in the Coorow area for over one hundred years. Founded in 1906, the farm has been in the Rudduck family for 114 years and has passed down through four generations. It has been at the forefront of agricultural practice in WA, with Arnold Rudduck serving many years on the board of Wesfarmers, and its conservation work with both Carnaby Cockatoos and the Buntine Marchagee Catchment garnering Alison Rudduck an OAM. It is also notable for having served over 100 years as a meteorological measuring point.
