

De BURGH FAMILY

The de Burgh family association with Western Australian began with the arrival in 1841 of the brothers Henry and Robert on the "James Matthews". Their history is recorded in 'The Breakaways' written by Robert's great-grandson William John de Burgh and his wife Margaret. This collection consists chiefly of personal letters written to Robert's grandson, Robert Sidney Maxwell de Burgh by his own family, by members of the Lefroy family and of inward and outward business correspondence. Robert, always known as Sidney, was the eldest of the seven children of Henry Augustus de Burgh who had married Annette Elizabeth Lefroy in 1878. After being tutored with his Brockman cousins at Cheriton he was formally educated in England, firstly at Dulwich College and subsequently at King's School, Ely. He took over the management of Cowalla on the Moore River in 1904, married Rachel Lukin in 1909 and farmed at Cowalla for the remainder of his life, whilst also being active in local government. Frequent mention is made in the letters of the proposed sale of Cowalla but it remained in the family's hands until 1982. In 2002 the family bought back 250 acres that included the original homestead and cottage. Two brief genealogies have been added to the collection to assist in identification of the de Burgh and Lefroy family members among the letter writers.
