

TANNER, WILLIAM, 1801-1845

William Tanner arrived on the "Drummore" on 1st February 1831 with his wife Hester, nee Viveash (1805-1846) and one male child. He was allowed to select 35,000 acres and took up locations in the Swan and Avon districts. He farmed on the Upper Swan at his property, "Baskerville Estate". The family left the colony on 14 January 1844, on the "Napolean".
