

REV. SEALIN GARLETT. UNITING CHURCH

Reverend Garlett was a respected elder of the Noongar community and a Minister of the Uniting Church in Coolbellup. He was born in 1957 in Bruce Rock and grew up speaking Noongar language and learning stories from his elders. He conducted weddings, baptisms, funerals, Welcome to Country ceremonies, and pastoral care. Chairman of the United Aboriginal and Islander Christian Congress, he operated an indigenous funeral company, Congress Funerals.

The collection consists of records of funerals of indigenous people in Western Australia, including some application forms, permits, death certificates, notes, mass service booklets that were created in the course of organising the funerals by Congress Funerals. Content of each file varies, from one to several pages.
